

- Available from June 9-18, 2024 and for pre-trip orientation, periodic follow up meetings, and presentations over the course of the following school year.
- Turn in signed liability waiver, medical information, and other pre-trip forms upon request.

- Be physically able to camp, hike several miles, and carry personal and group gear.
